Introduction

At Edmund de Moundeford Primary School we ask that all children wear school uniform when attending school, or when participating in school-organised events outside normal school hours.

Aims and Objectives

Our policy on school uniform is based on the belief that we are pleased to wear a uniform that:

- Promotes a sense of pride in our school
- Helps to create a sense of community and belonging towards the school
- Identifies pupils with the school
- Prevents pupils from wearing 'fashion clothes' that could be distracting in class

School Uniform List

Reception to Year 5 (Robins, Puffins, Owls, Kingfishers, Kestrels and Hawks):

- 1) There is the choice of a red jumper or cardigan. School logo jumpers and cardigans can be purchased from My Clothing. Logos do not have to be on the uniform, so purchases can be made from supermarkets or online from other providers.
- 2) White polo shirts should be worn.



- 3) Plain black or grey trousers/skirts/shorts.

Year 6/ Eagles

- 1) There is the choice of a black jumper or cardigan. School logo jumpers and cardigans can be purchased from My Clothing. Logos do not have to be on the uniform, so purchases can be made from supermarkets or online from other providers.
- 2) White polo shirts should be worn.



- 3) Plain black or grey trousers/skirts/shorts.

Footwear for all children

Black or grey low heeled shoes (not trainers) should be worn.

PE Kit for all children except Robins (Robins do not need a PE kit).

- 1) Red t shirt



- 2) For colder weather a plain black or red zip up top (any supplier) or one of the jackets below from My school:



- 3) Black or grey jogging/tracksuit bottoms or shorts
- 4) Black, white or grey socks and trainers
- 5) For children with long hair, please provide a hairband so that hair can be tied up

PE kit should be worn to school on the days children have PE.

Backpacks

Children will be given a school backpack when they first come to school. This should fit in everything that they need for school each day.

Nails, make-up, hair dye and tattoos.

Pupils are not allowed to wear fingernail polish or false nails. Make-up is also not allowed. Hair dye is not allowed, neither are tattoos (including fake tattoos).

Jewellery/Accessories

Pupils may wear a watch (no smart watches) and one pair of small, stud earrings. All jewellery must be removed for PE by the pupil or taken out at home. The school will be unable to take any responsibility for any watches or jewellery that are lost.

Clothing or accessories which are related to religious beliefs are welcomed but we ask that parents inform us of this before the child arrives in school wearing them.

Hair Accessories

Hair bands, ribbons, bows or 'scrunchies' should be small, plain and in school colours.

Naming Clothing and Property

Please ensure all clothing and property is clearly marked so that lost articles may be easily traced and returned.
