Ensure the dining area is ready for service and safely maintained (setting up, clearing spills, wiping down tables).

Playground & Safety Leader

Actively supervise the pupil in the playground, promoting safe and inclusive games and supporting organised play activities.

Resolve minor conflicts with patience and fairness, reporting serious incidents promptly.

Manage indoor 'wet play' activities when weather requires it.

Welfare & Care

Act as the first point of contact for minor injuries, referring to a first aider if needed.

Actively monitor the child with specific dietary needs to ensure their safety.

Maintain continuous vigilance to ensure all the child remains safe within the school's designated premises.
